Sunday School Pre-Nursery Class (2015)

Many of us heralded in the New Year 2015 with joy. This is no exception for us who are serving in the Pre-Nursery Sunday School class. We bade farewell to those leaving us to



join the Nursery class, and then welcomed the new faces with much anticipation.

The first few months are always trying for the newcomers and their parents. Some will take weeks or even months to settle into the class and adjust to the class routines. Crying and separation anxiety are commonplace and we usually assure the anxious parents that all will be well... eventually. Our Pre-Nursery Sunday School class caters to children aged between 18 months and 3 years old. This is the only class which kick-starts Sunday School lessons with playtime to get the little ones to warm up to us and each other. Then comes Singspiration, the most enjoyable segment for the children, for many love singing praises to the Lord. Story time and Worksheet segments are deemed the most 'laborious' for the children as they are required to sit down to listen attentively to the bible story and thereafter to complete a simple worksheet. Parents of younger toddlers often stay

onto look after their children to ensure they remain attentive and we appreciate their help in this. Sometimes, we chuckle at the fact that there are actually more adults than kids in the class!

As the weeks pass, I can see how God is working among our little ones. We celebrate every small achievement - from singing well, keeping up with the song actions to remembering the bible story and reciting the memory verses. These are sweet moments that spur me on in this ministry when I feel down and



tired. Lesson preparation is always a challenge to me as I realize that children below three years old have really short attention spans. Engaging the little ones and telling the bible story in a succinct and yet simple manner are important for them to learn the story, but not easy to achieve all the time. It is my prayer that God will continue to grant us wisdom and diligence in lesson preparation and use us to plant the seeds of faith in the little ones.
