
AdSS7-The destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah

(1) Background – The LORD had spoken to Abraham that He would be destroying Sodom and Gomorrah for their grievous sins. (Gen 18:32-33)

(2) The 2 visitors (angels) met Lot in Sodom. (Gen 19:1)



(3) Lot invited the 2 visitors to his house to spend the night. (Gen 19:2)

(4) All the men of Sodom surrounded Lot's house. They wanted to "know" the 2 visitors. (Gen 19:4-5)

(6) The people of Sodom wanted the 2 visitors and pressured Lot. (Gen 19:9)

(7) The visitors told Lot to gather his relatives out of Sodom as they would be destroying Sodom. (Gen 19:12-13)

(c) Future Judgment of the Great White Throne (Rev 20:11-15)


(13) Spiritual Lesson:
