

## **Moses and the Ten Commandments**

Exodus 19 - 20, 32, 34

 Background: Moses and the Israelites were at the foot of Mt Sinai.

Exodus 19: 20-21 Moses had gone up the mountain. God told Moses to go down to warn the people not to force their way to see the Lord.




Exodus 19:25 Moses went down from Mt Sinai to the people.



Then out of the smoke and fire, God spoke and the words were plain and clear.



Exodus 20:2-3 'I am the Lord your God who has brought you out of the land of Egypt and out of bondage. You shall have no other gods before me.

## XIX The Law of God, Westminster Confession of Faith

"V. <u>The moral law [The Ten Commandments] does forever bind all</u>, as well justified persons as others, to the obedience thereof; and that, not only in regard of the matter contained in it, but also in respect of the authority of God the Creator, who gave it. Neither does Christ, in the Gospel, any way dissolve, but much strengthen this obligation."

S/No	Ten Commandments	Comment
		The first 4 commandments are in relation to God.
1st	You shall have no other gods. Exodus 20:3.	<ul> <li>Worshipping false gods would be setting up rivals to the true God and is not permissible.</li> <li>Col 3:5:</li> </ul>
2nd	You shall not commit idolatry. Exodus 20:4. [Do not worship idols]	<i>"5 Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, <u>and covetousness, which is idolatry:</u></i>
		6 For which things' sake the wrath of God cometh on the children of disobedience:"

S/No.	Ten Commandments	Comment
		<ul> <li>Covetousness: eager or excessive desire or <u>greed</u>, especially for <u>wealth</u> or possessions.</li> <li>Ranking wealth above God is idolatry:</li> <li>Making a lot of money is not necessarily idolatry eg CEO of a big corporation.</li> </ul>
		<ul> <li>It is the:</li> <li>"<u>greed</u> for a lot of money" which is idolatry.</li> <li>We are not to worship or bow down to a figure or idol, including greed.</li> </ul>

S/No.	Ten Commandments	Comment
3rd	You shall not misuse the name of God. Exodus 20:7.	<ul> <li>Disrespectful use of God's name is commonly heard example: "JeCh!"</li> </ul>
	[God's name should be respectfully used]	"Ch!" "OMG!", "OG!"

S/No	Ten Commandments	Comment
4th	Keep the Sabbath holy. Exodus 20:8.	<ul> <li>Other than works of necessity and mercy, we should keep our Sunday as a day of rest.</li> </ul>
5th	Honour your father and mother. Exodus 20:12	<ul> <li>The next 6 commandments are in relation to people</li> <li>"Honour" means high respect.</li> <li>They must be respected and obeyed while under the parents' direct authority in the home prior to a young person's marriage (Gen 2:24).</li> <li>We obey our parents as long as it's consistent with God's teachings.</li> <li>Many do not have good relations with their parents. Nagging parents, etc. (Share).</li> </ul>
